# BIG BEND FLORIDA UNIT 153 REGION 3 APPLE STUFFED STRATA \*\*\* Serves 8 as a meal or 6 as a part of a buffet

### **Preparation Time 20 minutes**

#### **INGREDIENTS:**

2 tsp. butter

4 cups sliced Golden Delicious apples

4 Tbsp. granulated sugar, divided

12-14 slices cinnamon-swirl bread, crust removed and cut in half diagonally

34 cup chopped pecans, divided

1½ cups milk

½ tsp. ground cinnamon

5 large eggs

1 Tbsp. turbinado or granulated sugar

Thanks to Katherine Kamiya for the delicious egg bake recipes at the Saturday morning rally. The Apple Strata was prepared by Martina Pelley. The other 3 egg bake recipes will be in the next newsletter.

### **DIRECTIONS:**

Melt butter in a large nonstick skillet over medium-high heat. Add apples and 1 Tbsp. granulated sugar to pan. Sauté for 8 minutes or until apples are tender and lightly brown. Remove from heat and cool 5 minutes.

Coat an 11" x 7" x 2" glass or ceramic baking dish with non-stick spray. Arrange half of bread in dish, cutting to fit if necessary. Top with apple mixture and top with  $\frac{1}{2}$  cup of the pecans. Arrange remaining bread over pecans, cutting to fit if necessary.

Combine the remaining 3 Tbsp. of granulated sugar, milk, cinnamon, and eggs in a medium bowl, stirring with a whisk. Pour milk mixture through a strainer over bread, pressing down to submerge the bread. Cover and chill overnight in the refrigerator.

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Uncover dish. Sprinkle ¼ cup pecans and turbinado sugar evenly over the bread. Bake for 48 minutes or until a knife inserted in the center comes out clean. Let rest for 15 minutes.

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
