PUMPKIN BREAD From: Ginger Uhrich-Spenard

Makes 2 loaves or 1 Bundt

INGREDIENTS:

2 Loaf	4 Loafs	6 Loafs	
3 cups	6 cups	9 cups	Sifted Flour
1/2 tsp.	1 tsp.	1½ tsp.	Baking Powder
1 tsp.	2 tsp.	3 tsp.	Baking Soda
1 tsp.	2 tsp.	3 tsp.	Nutmeg (go light)
1 tsp.	2 tsp.	3 tsp.	Ground Cloves
1 tsp.	2 tsp.	3 tsp. 🔄	Cinnamon (best stick cinnamon toasted then crushed)
1/2 tsp.	1 tsp.	1½ tsp.	Salt
~~~~~	~~~~~	~~~~~~	UNITI Orlando
3 cups	6 cups	9 <mark>cups</mark>	Sugar BCCL Tampa
1 cup	2 cups	3 cups	Vegetable Oil
3	6	9	Eggs
1 can	2 cans	3 cans	Pumpkin (2 cups puree)
1 cup	2 cups	3 cups	Chopped Walnuts


In medium bowl, sift dry ingredients, spices, & salt. In large bowel, mix sugar, oil, & eggs. Stir until well blended. Stir in Pumpkin. Gradually add dry ingredients, stir well after each addition. Fold in nuts.

Bake 1 hour & 15-20 min (about 1 hour for loaves) @ 350 degrees in <u>WELL GREASED</u> Bundt pan or 2 loaf pans. Cool for 10 min or more.
